THANK YOU ALL FOR SUPPORTING US AND HELPING TO RAISE THIS FANTASTIC AMOUNT from September-December 2023! We couldn't do it without the support of each of you. At the HSA meeting held in January 2024 we were delighted to be able to update both schools on the total funds raised and were able to give each school £3,000. The Infant School will be putting this money towards their Forest School Pond and some new iPads. The Junior School will be putting this money towards their Community Garden project.

The HSA have joined the TerraCycle Writing Instruments Recycling Programme!

This is a recycling scheme enabling us to send off writing instruments to be recycled and in turn receive points that can then be turned into a donation to the HSA!

The more we send off, the more points we earn, the more funds we can raise. So we NEED YOU to get on board and start recycling your used and unwanted writing instruments with us.

We have set up drop off points in both the Infant and Junior Schools so that you can easily drop off your writing instruments to be recycled.

We are able to accept:

All brands of writing instruments, whether in plastic or metal –pen, felt tip, highlighter, marker, correction fluid pot or tape, mechanical pencil and eraser pen (cap included).

We DON'T accept: wooden pencils, glue sticks, rubbers, rulers, chalk sticks or cutting objects.

Please do support this scheme if you can, as not only does it stop these items ending up in landfill, and thus doing your bit for the environment, it also allows you a simple way to support the HSA and help raise funds for the schools.





Have you thought about joining the HSA **Lucky Lotto (200 Club)**?

It is a monthly school lottery – a quick and easy way to support our schools.

It's just £1 per month, per ticket! You can pick as many tickets as you wish.

The HSA Lucky Lotto (200 Club) gives 3 lucky winners a chance to share half of the stake money – 25% to the winner, 15% for second place and 10% for third place. 50% of the money goes to the schools and the other 50% represents the prize pot; so the more you play the more you can win!

The money raised helps to fund all the things that help enrich

the children's education at both Harnham Junior and Harnham Infant schools.

You can buy as many tickets as you wish as long as you are over 16 years of age. It is open to parents, teachers, governors, relatives and friends – so spread the word!
