#### Our Harnham Infant School Reading Spine:

At Harnham Infant School we love to share texts with the children, reading stories, poems, and nonfiction texts aloud each day during Read and Feed (snack time) is one of our favourite times of the day! This year we have introduced a Reading Spine of texts to our Reading Curriculum, each year group has chosen a selection of key, high quality texts that the children will listen to for a whole week at a time. You may hear your children talking about our 'Reading Dogs', these are a set of five characters that support children to recognise and apply different reading skills.

We use the Reading Dogs during our Reading Spine sessions; you can find some images of the dogs below as well as some information about how we use each dog.

Victor Vocabulary – Victor helps us to understand new words.

Rex Retriever – Rex helps us to find out information from the text.

**Sequencing Suki** – Suki helps us to put a text back in the right order or to talk about what has happened so far.

**Inference Iggy** – Iggy asks us to reach a conclusion/answer based on what we have read and what we think.

**Predicting Pip** – Pip asks us to think about what might be coming next, she asks us to say what we think a book might be about by just looking at the front cover!


