# ICT Acceptable Use Policy for Parents

# **Online Safety**

During our Year 2 online safety learning, there have been a lot of children talking about playing online games like Roblox. Please make sure that you have restrictions enabled on children's devices. Some children were talking about Brookhaven, which is an action game for the Roblox Platform. From our research on this, it would appear that the recommended age for this platform is 13+. We have found the following information:

# • Parents Need to Know

Parents need to know that Brookhaven RP is an action game for the Roblox platform. It doesn't offer much guidance to show kids how to use features in the game, although they can view a list of directional commands at any time. Customizable avatar characteristics include different skin tones. Vehicle and other upgrades are sold for Robux, the platform's in-app currency. Kids don't have to buy anything, and there's virtually no pressure to. Other players sometimes swear and make inappropriate comments in the ongoing on-screen chat, which kids can click to hide but may choose to leave open. While the game isn't necessarily violent, some of the objects kids receive at the start in their backpack, which they can use whenever they'd like, include guns, handcuffs, and a bomb. While kids far younger than 13 will want to play, given the Roblox platform's continuing challenges with problematic content, it's strongly recommended against unsupervised play for kids under that age.
