
Update from HC3S regarding School Lunches:

Throughout the pandemic, we've always had the safety of our customers and colleagues at the forefront of our minds. Having reviewed our current situation we want to write to you with an update regarding meal arrangements for the return to school and college in January 2022.

Regretfully, our staffing situation remains challenging, both with recruitment and sickness levels which are expected at this time of year. Our two priorities are to take effective steps to keep staff, students and pupils safe; and to deliver the best, as near normal, lunchtime experience. This means that we will endeavour to provide our daily choice of hot two course meals, both non-meat and meat. However, where staffing issues occur, our operational managers will liaise with those schools to discuss and agree how best to adapt the meal service where it is needed.

We believe these priorities support each other and that this plan of action will be in the best interests of pupils, students and colleagues. We rely on upon your support and are appreciative of you working with HC3S.

Just for Fun - Game of the Week:

This week's game promotes questioning skills. It is called **Who am !?**Decide on a famous person or character who your child will know well.
You could write it on a sticky label and attach it to them so that they can't see it if you want to. Children need to ask questions in order to identify who they are. E.g. How old am !? Am I a cartoon character? Do I live in Disneyland? Etc. You could vary this by only asking yes or no questions or by limiting the number of questions children can ask before making a guess.
